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To be covered by the district's liability insurance, activities sponsored by school connected groups and organizations must be conducted on school premises or other areas where the district is leasing or renting the location for events and when the booster group complies with Board policy 1230 and administrative regulation 1230, plus other conditions outlined below (AR 1230).

All activities conducted off school premises must be approved in advance by the Assistant Superintendent for Business in order to be covered by the district's liability policy.

The district's liability policy will not cover any activity sponsored by a school support group in which any form of alcoholic beverage is served.

All activities sponsored by school-support groups on school premises must conform with district regulations related to non-smoking, adequate security, and other conditions outlined at the time a facility is requested for use.

Parent/guardian clubs shall not hire district employees without prior approval from the Superintendent or designee.

School-connected organizations automatically grant the district the right to audit their financial records at any time, either by district personnel or by a CPA.
